Objective

- Text: 10 point font, Margin: Left-2.54 cm; Right-2 cm.
- Top: First page 3cm; other pages-2cm; Bottom-2cm.
- Figure: To be within text; caption at the bottom.
- Poster size: Length 120 cm and width 90 cm.
