To correct data, use a single strikethrough line. Do not black out or use erasers.	1. Small fire Cover with wet cloth. Immediately tell staff (= person in blue coat).
	2. Burn (chemical/fire/hot, no exceptions) Immediately wash skin with lots of tap water. Immediately tell staff (= person in blue coat). Keep washing until staff tells you to stop. Do not wipe with cloth.
	3. Chemical in eyes (no exceptions) Immediately wash eyes with eye washer. Immediately tell staff (= person in blue coat). Keep washing until staff tells you to stop.
	4. Chemical in mouth (no exceptions) If not yet swallowed, spirit out now. Immediately rinse mouth (= gargle) with tap water Immediately tell staff (= person in blue coat). Do not do other first aid. Do not try to vomit.
	5. Bad smell gas or unknown white precipitate (= solid in liquid) Move the apparatus (= tool) close to the ventilation (= air outlet). Immediately tell staff (= person in blue coat).
	6. Broken glass Avoid cuts: do not touch sharp parts. Immediately tell staff (= person in blue coat).
